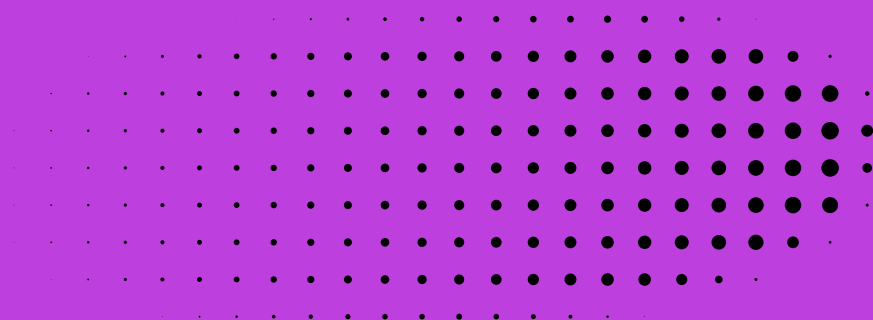
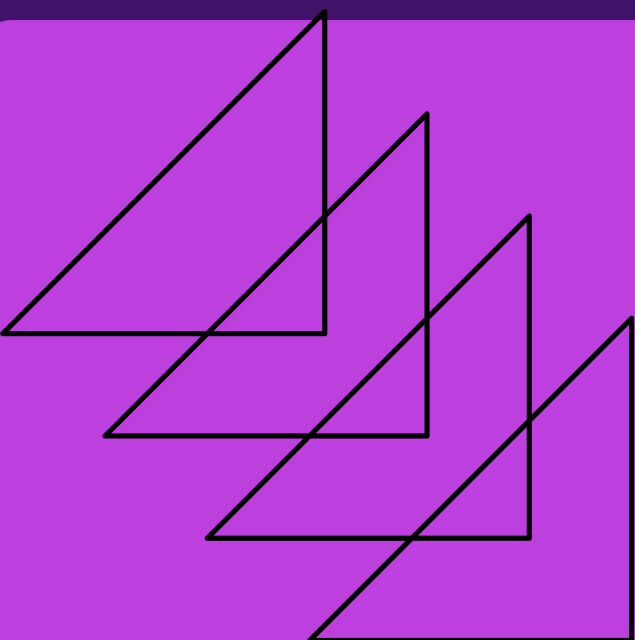

# **2025 ANNUAL REPORT**



# INTRODUCTION

The year 2025 was a season of growth, restoration and renewed hope for Wings of Hope Rescue Home. As we reflect on the past year, we are grateful for the progress made in advancing our mission of supporting vulnerable pregnant teenagers, young mothers and their children.

Across many communities in Kenya, teenage pregnancy often comes with stigma, school dropout, family rejection and limited access to healthcare. Many young mothers find themselves without a safe place to stay, emotional support or the opportunity to continue their education.

Wings of Hope Rescue Home exists to respond to these challenges by providing a safe, supportive and nurturing environment where young mothers can heal, rebuild their lives and pursue new opportunities for themselves and their children.

In 2025, our home provided shelter and care to 42 young mothers and their babies. We welcomed 8 pregnant teenage girls into our care and celebrated the safe delivery of 7 healthy babies, each representing hope, resilience and a fresh beginning.

A major milestone this year was the successful acquisition of our permanent premises, securing a long-term home for our organization and ensuring stability for the girls and babies we serve. This achievement strengthens our ability to continue offering safety, dignity and long-term support to vulnerable young mothers.

Education and empowerment remained central to our work. During the year:

- 8 teenage mothers were reintegrated back into school
- 6 children were enrolled in school
- 4 young mothers enrolled in college to pursue higher education

These achievements reflect our holistic approach to restoration — supporting not only survival but also dignity, confidence and future opportunities.

We extend our heartfelt appreciation to our partners, donors, volunteers and staff who made this work possible. Your generosity continues to transform lives.

As we look ahead to 2026, we remain committed to expanding our reach, strengthening our programs and continuing to serve as a place where hope is restored and futures are rebuilt.

## OUR ORGANIZATION

Founded in 2016, Wings of Hope Rescue Home is a community-based organization located in Kamulu, Nairobi County, Kenya.

The organization was established to respond to the growing number of vulnerable teenage girls facing pregnancy, abandonment, abuse and social stigma. Many of these young mothers are forced to leave school and often lack the support systems necessary to care for themselves and their children.

Wings of Hope Rescue Home provides a safe residential environment where pregnant teenagers and young mothers receive protection, care and opportunities to rebuild their lives.

Guided by Christian values and deeply rooted in the community, the organization offers a holistic model of support that includes:

- Safe shelter and care
- Counseling and psychosocial support
- Education reintegration
- Vocational skills training
- Life skills development and mentorship

Our goal is not only to provide temporary care but to empower each young mother to regain confidence, pursue education or skills training, and build a stable future for herself and her child.

# WHO WE SERVE

Wings of Hope Rescue Home serves vulnerable pregnant teenagers, young mothers, and their babies who are facing crisis situations such as family rejection, abuse, poverty or lack of safe housing.

Many girls who come to our home arrive during extremely difficult moments in their lives. Some have been forced to leave school due to pregnancy, while others have been abandoned or rejected by their families. Many lack access to proper healthcare during pregnancy and have limited support to care for their babies.

At Wings of Hope, we provide immediate protection and long-term support to ensure that every girl has the opportunity to recover, regain stability, and pursue a brighter future.



## Key 2025 Statistics

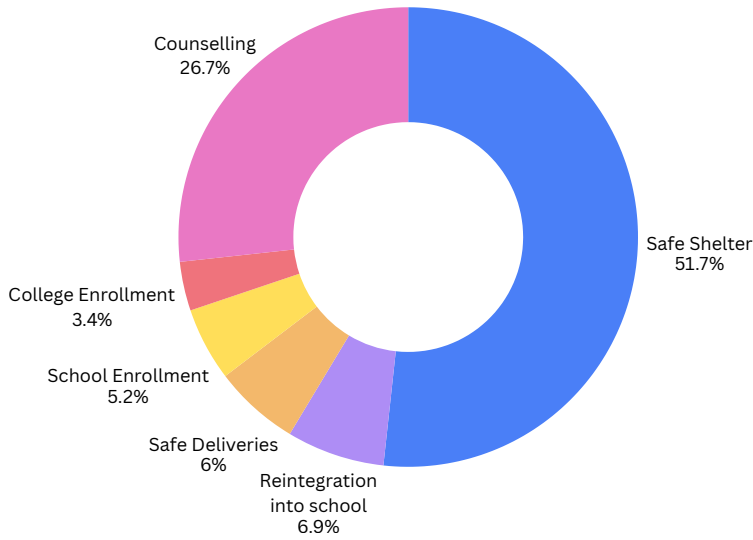
- 8 pregnant teenage girls admitted
- 7 babies safely delivered
- 42 girls and their babies provided with shelter and care.
- 8 teenage mothers reintegrated back to school
- 6 children enrolled in school
- 4 teenage mothers enrolled in college
- 336 counseling sessions provided
- 1,460 meals served
- 112 community outreach activities

These numbers represent lives transformed and new opportunities created for young mothers and their children.



# 2025 IMPACT HIGHLIGHTS

Throughout 2025, Wings of Hope Rescue Home continued to provide comprehensive support across several key program areas.



## Safe shelter and care

Providing a safe and stable home remains our largest area of impact. In 2025, Wings of Hope provided residential care for 42 young mothers and their babies. The girls received accommodation, nutritious meals (over 1,460 served during the year), clothing, and a nurturing environment where they could recover physically and emotionally. A major milestone within this program was the acquisition of our permanent premises, securing a stable and long-term home where vulnerable girls and their babies can find safety, healing and support.

## Education Reintegration

Education plays a vital role in restoring independence and future opportunities. Through mentorship, counseling, and educational support, 8 teenage mothers successfully returned to school, allowing them to continue pursuing their academic goals.

## School & College enrollment

Ensuring children have access to education is equally important. During the year, 6 children were enrolled in school, ensuring they start their learning journey.

## Counselling & Psychosocial Support

In 2025, Wings of Hope facilitated 336 counseling sessions, giving young mothers safe spaces to process trauma, rebuild confidence, and strengthen resilience. Through guidance and mentorship, the girls overcame fear and rediscovered hope, laying foundations for stability and empowerment.

## Safe deliveries and Maternal Health

Access to proper healthcare during pregnancy is critical for both mother and child. In 2025, 7 young mothers delivered healthy babies safely with medical support and care.

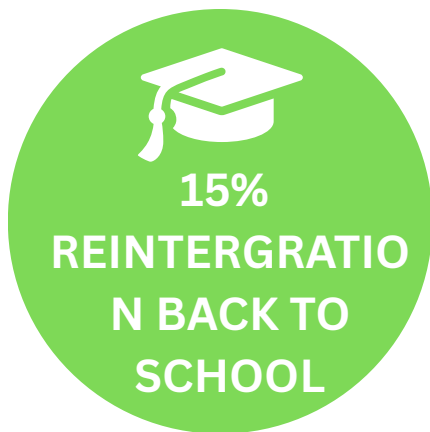

# PROGRAMS AND REACH

Wings of Hope Rescue Home operates several programs designed to provide comprehensive support to vulnerable young mothers.



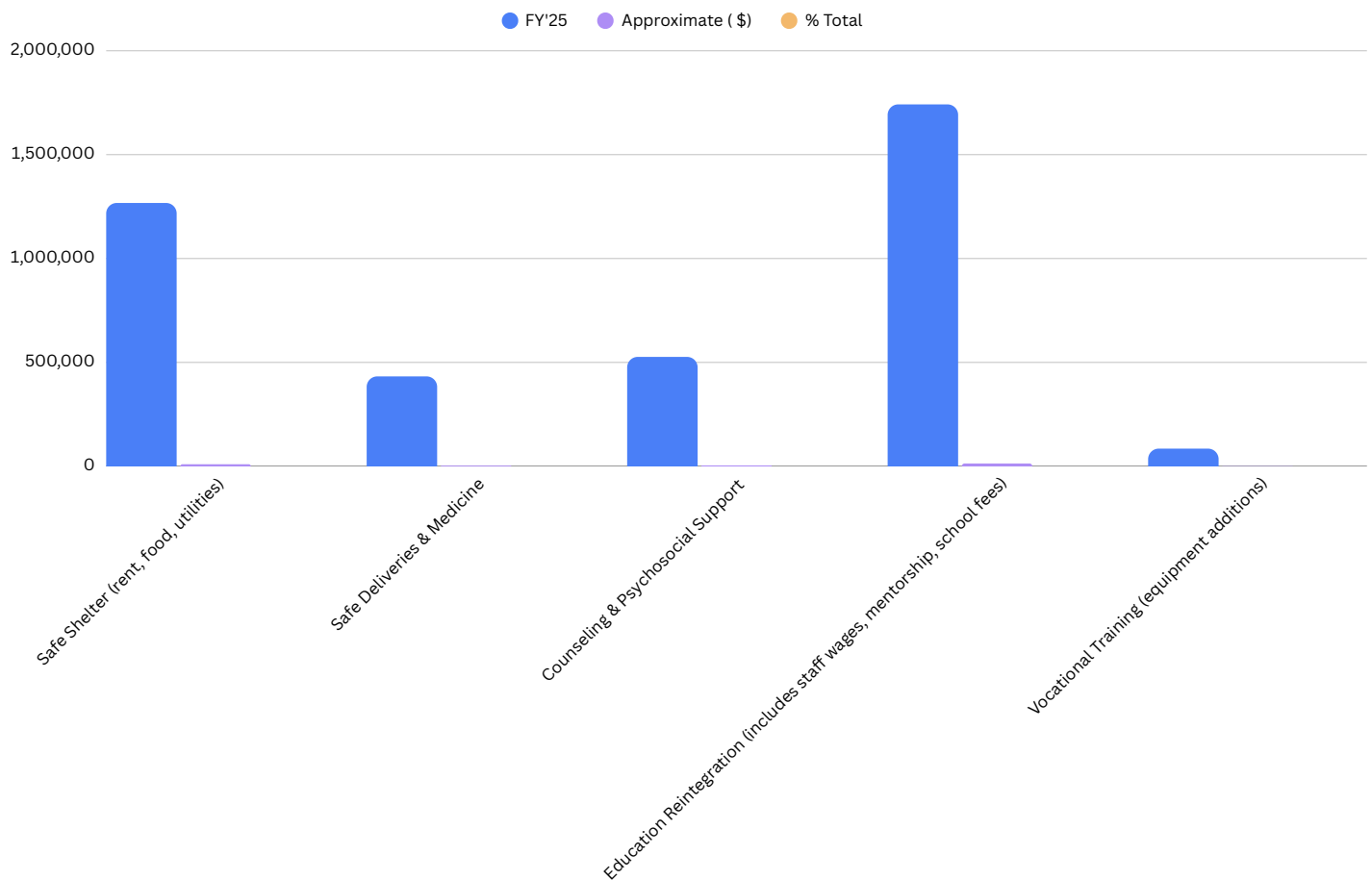
These programs work together to provide holistic support to vulnerable teenage mothers and their babies. From safe shelter and healthcare to counseling, education support, and vocational training, Wings of Hope focuses on both immediate care and long-term empowerment. Through this integrated approach, young mothers are supported to heal, rebuild their confidence, and develop the skills and opportunities needed to build stable and independent futures.

Beyond the home, Wings of Hope also reached into the wider community, **conducting 112 outreach activities in 2025**. These engagements strengthened awareness, built networks of support, and helped reduce stigma, ensuring that vulnerable girls are embraced not only within the Rescue Home but also by the communities around them.

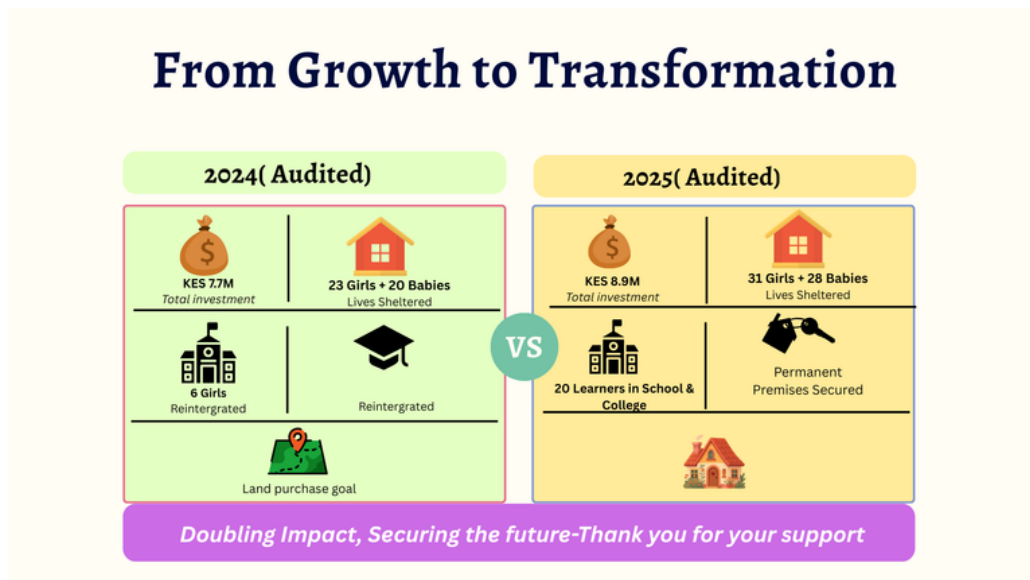
In 2025, Wings of Hope Rescue Home invested KES 8.9 million (audited) into shelter, maternal care, education reintegration, vocational training, counseling and administration. This represents an increase from KES 7.7 million in 2024 (audited), reflecting program expansion and donor trust.

- Program Expenses: KES 4,195,682
- Administrative Expenses: KES 4,586,247
- Net Surplus: KES 97,366

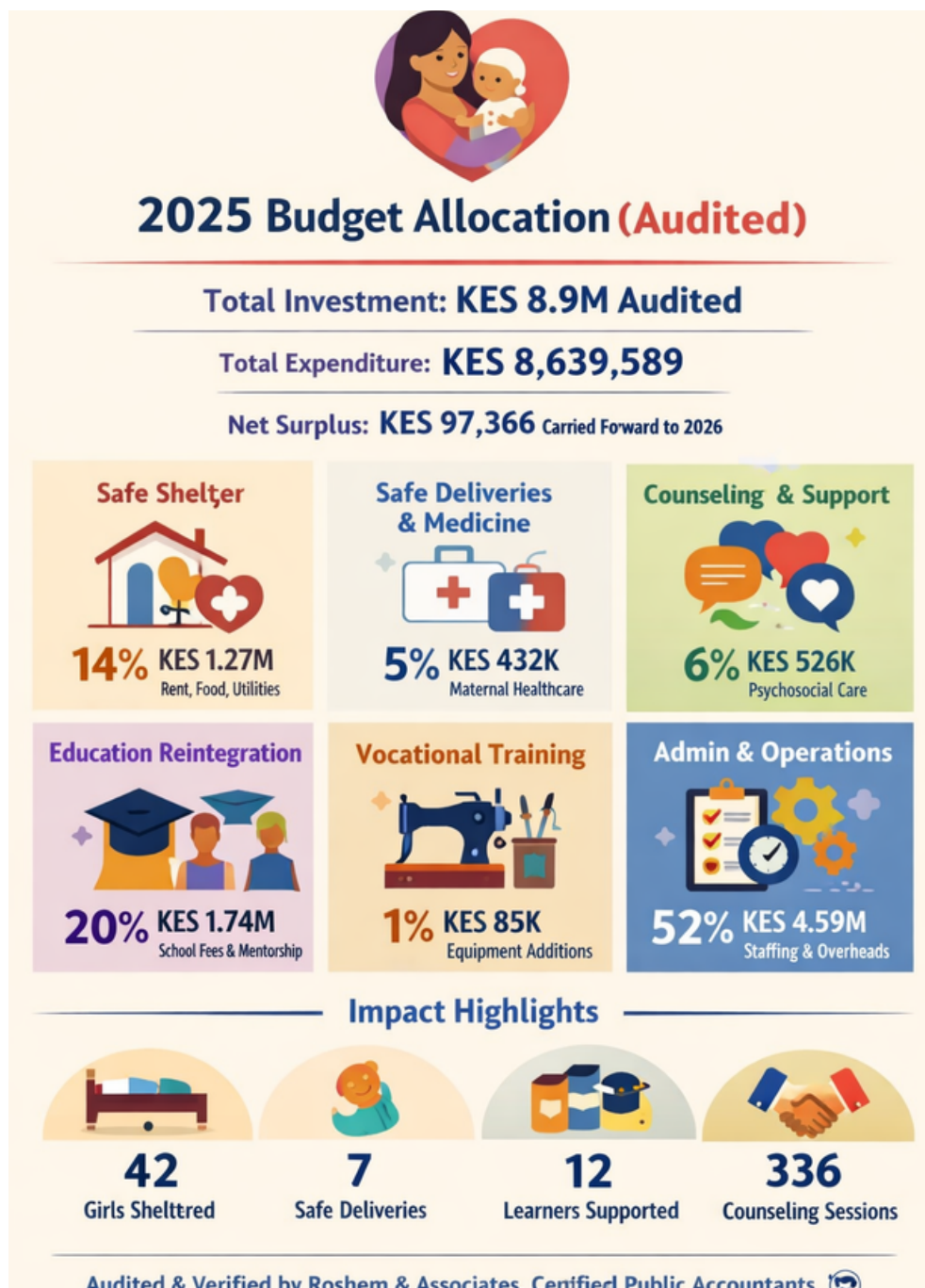

# 2025 BUDGET ALLOCATION

In 2025, Wings of Hope Rescue Home invested KES 8.9 million (audited) into shelter, maternal care, education reintegration, vocational training, counseling and administration. This audited breakdown shows how donor contributions were allocated and the impact they created. While administrative expenses appear significant, they include staff salaries and wages – the human investment that makes education reintegration, counseling, and daily care possible. Every shilling entrusted to us was used to restore dignity, provide safety, and open new opportunities for vulnerable young mothers and their children.



# BENEFICIARY JOURNEY

## A Graduate's Success

Sarah was among the very first girls rescued by Wings of Hope Rescue Home. When she arrived, she was broken and overwhelmed by the challenges of teenage pregnancy. With no safe place to turn, she found refuge at Wings of Hope, where she was welcomed with compassion and dignity.

The home walked with Sarah through every stage of her journey—providing shelter, counseling and emotional support during her pregnancy, guiding her through delivery, and helping her care for her baby. Beyond immediate care, Wings of Hope ensured that Sarah returned to school, believing that education was the key to her long-term independence and confidence.

Step by step, Sarah rebuilt her life. Her determination, combined with the consistent support of mentors and caregivers, carried her through secondary school and into higher education. Today, she stands as a powerful example of transformation: in June 2026, Sarah will graduate with a Bachelor's Degree in International Studies from one of Kenya's prestigious universities.

Her journey is more than personal success—it is a testimony to the holistic model of care at Wings of Hope. What began as rescue and shelter grew into empowerment and restoration, proving that with faith, resilience, and opportunity, despair can be turned into dignity and hope. Sarah's story reminds us that every girl has the potential to rise, and that long-term impact is possible when communities invest in both healing and education.
